Delinquent Taxes

The 2016 taxes were due by January 31, 2017. As of July 1st penalty and interest has been added to any unpaid 2017 taxes in the amount of 18%. In addition a 20% Collection Fee is assessed.

2017 Appraisal Information

The Appraisal Review Board is holding hearings this month. Property owners who submitted appeals are being contacted about their protests, either informally, or with a notice of hearing date. Property owners who have not yet resolved their protests can potentially expedite a resolution by providing additional documentation that will support your assertion of value, such as recent closing statements, fee appraisals, photographs, or other documentation, and daytime contact information, including phone numbers and email address if possible.

Property owners who have a pending protest, and have received a notice of hearing date, have some scheduling options if their original hearing date is problematic. Property owners can request a one-time reschedule. This request must be made in writing (email or fax is acceptable) and be made at least one day in advance of their original hearing date. However the number of available hearing dates is limited, so the use of the allowed one-time reschedule should be carefully considered. In the event of second reschedule request, the Appraisal Review Board will decide if that request is granted.
